California Council for Interior Design Certification (CCIDC) Announces New Board Member

October 4, 2010) The Board Members of the California Council for Interior Design Certification (CCIDC) recently named a new Board Director, Michelle Eaton, replacing one whose terms of service have been completed. Ms. Eaton was confirmed by the CCIDC Board at its September 25th board meeting in San Diego to fill the designated seat for an ASID member for two three-year terms.

Michelle Eaton CID, ASID, WFCP has been an active member of ASID since 1991. She has served as the ASID California Central/Nevada Chapter President three times. In addition, Ms. Eaton has served on the ASID National Board for a total of two years, and on the ASID Ethics Committee as its Chair.

The CCIDC is responsible for administering the requirements of the Certified Interior Designers Law, under Chapter 3.9, Section 5800 of the California Business and Professions code. The CCIDC Board of Directors consists of seven Certified Interior Designers and four Public Members, who are appointed or elected to serve two three-year terms. Public Board Meetings are held three times a year in alternating areas of the state. The CCIDC is a private non-profit organization that reports to the Senate Business, Professions, and Economic Development Committee.
