## California Council for Interior Design Certification (CCIDC) Announces Three New Board Members

She is a Certified Kitchen Designer, Certified Aging in Place Specialist, and Green Building Professional. She previously served on the CCIDC board just over 10 years ago as a Director and is a past President of CCIDC.

The CCIDC is responsible for administering the requirements of the Certified Interior Designers Law, under Chapter 3.9, Section 5800 of the California Business and Professions code. The CCIDC Board of Directors consists of seven Certified Interior Designers and four Public Members, who are appointed or elected to serve two three-year terms and a possible one-year grace term. Public Board Meetings are held three times a year in alternating areas of the state. The CCIDC is a private non-profit organization that reports to the Senate Business, Professions, and Economic Development Committee.
