The CCIDC Board of Directors consists of seven Certified Interior Designers and four Public Members, who are appointed or elected to serve two three-year terms. Public Board Meetings are held three times a year in alternating areas of the state. The CCIDC is a private non-profit organization that reports to the Senate Business, Professions, and Economic Development Committee.
