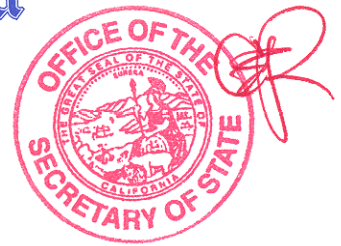

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF CCIDC, INC., a

California mutual benefit corporation

The undersigned certifies that:

1. He is the incorporator of the Corporation, formed under the laws of the State of California for the purpose of forming a non-profit mutual benefit corporation.

2. The name of the Corporation is:

“CCIDC, Inc.”

3. This Corporation is a nonprofit mutual benefit corporation organized under the Nonprofit Mutual Benefit Corporation Law. The purpose of this Corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under such law. The specific purpose of the Corporation is to establish and implement professional standards and educational requirements, educate the public, and facilitate interior design professional’s compliance with a uniform standards and code of ethics in order to provide for the protection, education, health, safety and welfare of the public. This Corporation does not contemplate any distribution prohibited by Chapter 2, Part 3, Division 2 of Title 1 of the California Corporations Code. and no part of the net earnings or property of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member. private individual, or other person or entity except for the payment of reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article V below. In the event any such net earnings or property are distributed after dissolution, then such assets will be distributed to a person or persons carrying on a charitable, religious, or public purpose or purposes. The Corporation shall further neither engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of the Corporation set forth in those provisions of the California Corporations Code referenced above, nor perform any activity that violates the Corporation’s status and qualification as an interior design organization as provided in Section 5800 et. seq. of the California Business & Professions Code, as such statute may be amended from time to time, including but not limited to the Corporation’s qualification as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding Section of any future federal tax statutes (the “IRC”).

4. The Corporation’s agent for service of process is Daniel S. Weber, located at 1761 Hotel Circle South Suite 200, San Diego, CA 92108.


5. This Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, or scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the IRC. The Corporation intends on qualifying as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the IRC, and shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a qualifying organization exempt from federal income tax

under Section 501(c)(3) of the IRC, or the corresponding Section of any future federal tax statutes. The Corporation shall further not engage in any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the IRC, or the corresponding Section of any future federal tax statutes.
