



September 2005 CCIDC Board Meeting Highlights

The CCIDC Board of Directors held its regularly scheduled board meeting in downtown San Francisco at the Nikko Hotel. Representatives from CLCID, CIDA and Certified Interior Designers attended the meeting. All CCIDC meetings are open to the public.

The CCIDC board has now received examination validation documentation and Occupational Analyses from the NCIDQ and NKBA examinations. The CQRID Occupational Analysis is expected next week. The board will then move forward to certify the validation of all three examinations as required by California law.

The April 2005 California Codes and Regulations Examination (CCRE) had 81 candidates registered, 62 candidates that attended, and 41 candidates were successful in passing the test giving a 66% passing rate.

CCIDC continues to work on educating California building officials about Certified Interior Designers and will attend CALBO's annual meeting in Palm Springs in February.

The CCIDC web site has been completely updated with a new section for students and non-Certified Interior Designers with examination information, a complete listing of California interior design schools, and information on how to become a CID. The board also approved the addition of a "Disciplinary Action" page, which should be online in the next few weeks. This will list those CID's the board has disciplined or received complaints against.

The 2004 audited financial statements for CCIDC are almost complete and will be posted on CCIDC's web site in the next month or so.

Senate Bill 232 is on the governor's desk for signature and extends the "Certified Interior Designer Law" from January 1, 2007 until January 1, 2008. It is expected that Sunset review hearings on the CID law will commence in the Fall of 2006.
